



ARTIST IN RESIDENCE APPLICATION INFORMATION

APPLICATION DEADLINES

Application deadline is March 1st of each year, (for residencies May to October). **Completed applications must be clearly postmarked by this deadline to be considered.**

Late applications will not be accepted.

Notification of results will be mailed by March 31st. You may apply anytime before the 1st March.

APPLICATION MATERIALS

In order to be processed, your application must include all the following materials:

- The original and one copy of the APPLICATION FORM.
- Your professional resume of no more than two pages.
- Work samples*, as specified below.
- Two letters of Reference, sent directly to PADIÉS by the Referent on the enclosed FORM. Applicants are responsible for sending the forms to Referent, for providing them appropriate information, and confirming that the letters have been sent. Referrers should be individuals who know the applicant personally, and who can comment knowledgeably about their work.

Application deadlines also apply to Referent letters.

- A non-refundable application fee of 37€ made payable by check to “PADIÉS Management” or online via Pay Pal from the PADIÉS site
- A self-addressed postcard for notification of the receipt of the completed application.

WORK SAMPLES

Samples should be of recent, finished work that reflects your highest accomplishment. See detail.

Send only the materials requested below.

Additional support materials, such as exhibition cards, book reviews or published interviews, will be discarded.

Literature: Writers working in fiction, non-fiction, drama and poetry. *one typescript*

of no more than 30 pages (approximately 10,000 words), consisting of a short story, a one-act play, or a portion of a novel, play, or other work, accompanied by a synopsis only if necessary. *Poets should send 10 short (one page) poems* or appropriate excerpts from a longer poem. Please do not send published books: photocopies of selected pages are acceptable, as long as the total sample does not exceed 10,000 words. It is helpful if writers who work in languages other than English submit typescripts in both the original and English translations.

Visual Arts: Artists whose finished works are visual images. *A DVD of 9 images scanned in minimum resolution 200dpi. DO NOT SEND SLIDES or other material.* DVD should be named with artist's name. On the DVD, name each piece with the title, dimensions in cms. **Include a written list** with titles, media, dimensions and date the work was completed.—do not send ANY additional material.

Musical Composition: *Two separate musical scores* and a clearly labeled *CD or DVD* of one or both of them. For works created without a score, a brief statement describing the recorded music should be included.

Media and Performance: Artists working in new genres, multi-media, performance art, experimental work combining more than one genre, electronic art forms: *One DVDs showing the same work*, clearly labeled with artist's name, in either PAL, NTSC or MPEG 2 or MPEG4. Segment should be no longer than 10 minutes, accompanied by a brief written explanation if necessary. Internet links are accepted but not recommended.

Film and Video: *One or maximum two DVDs* in PAL, NTSC or MPEG2 or MPEG4 formats *showing the work*, clearly labeled with artist's name and name of piece, cued to a segment no longer than 10 minutes, and accompanied by a written explanation if necessary. Screenwriters should send a 30-page segment of a screenplay, accompanied by a synopsis.

Your material will include:

- **the application form,**
- **two-page CV**
- **and work sample.**

Please submit to only one category per application.

* Work Samples will be returned only if they are accompanied by separate, self-addressed return envelopes with sufficient postage from France by prearranged payment. Contact questions.
